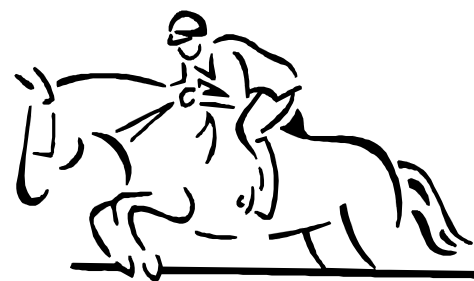

CLASS 42 BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER Fences not to exceed 50 cm. open to all novice combinations that have not won a first prize in working hunter classes

CLASS 43 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY For ponies not exceeding 15hh Fences not to exceed 60 cm Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony

CLASS 44 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER

Jumping section to split into small and large breeds, Fences not to exceed 60cm and 70 cm respectively.

CLASS 45 OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY For ponies not exceeding 15hh Fences not to exceed 80 cm Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony

LUNCH BREAK 30 Mins

CLASS 46 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE For horses exceeding 15hh Fences not to exceed 60cm

CLASS 47 OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE For horses exceeding 15hh Fences not to exceed 80cm

CLASS 37 CATEGORY B (expected to mature between 34" - 38"), any age, any sex.

CLASS 38 DRAUGHT TYPE open, any age, any sex not exceeding 34" at maturity.

CLASS 39 SOLID COLOUR to be judged 80% colour and 20% conformation open to horses any age and up to 38"

CLASS 40 BROKEN COLOUR & SPOTTED to be judged 80% colour 20% conformation open to horses any age and up to 38".

CLASS 41 JUNIOR HANDLER 16yrs & under, judged on handlers ability, not on the horse.

These classes are qualifiers for the UK National Championship Show and for the EMHA National High Point Awards, open to members only. The following miniature horse classes are open to members and non-members. Places 1st-3rd in each class will qualify.

RULES

Prize money may be withheld if insufficient starters.

Hats to B.S must be worn at all times when mounted.

It is advised that body protectors are worn whilst jumping.

No refunds will be given on entries

Please do not muck out horse boxes on the field!

All dogs must be kept on leads at ALL times.

Please put litter in the bins provided.

Warren Farm Stables cannot be held liable for any loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or property whilst at the show.

Any accident or injury must be reported to the show secretary for inclusion in the accident book.

The judges decision is final any objections should be made in writing within 30 mins of the class with a £25 deposit (refundable if upheld).

CLASS 2 BEST RIDER 8 YEARS AND UNDER - For riders on or off the lead rein. All lead reins must be attached to the noseband.

CLASS 3 BEST RIDER 14 YEARS AND UNDER - No lead reins

CLASS 4 BEST RIDER OPEN

CLASS 5 LEAD REIN / FIRST RIDDEN to be ridden on or off the lead rein riders to be 10 years or under, no cantering together, all lead reins must be attached to the noseband.

CLASS 6 BEST COMBINATION 10 -14 YEARS no lead reins

CLASS 7 BEST COMBINATION OPEN

CLASS 17 OPEN RIDDEN HUNTER for horses 4 years old or over exceeding 153 cms

CLASS 18 RIDDEN RETIRED RACEHORSE

CLASS 19 RIDDEN COLOURED 4 years or over, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out.

CLASS 20 RIDDEN PART BRED ARAB OR WELSH 4 years or over to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out.

CLASS 21 SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER 4 years old or over, Not to exceed 153cm

CLASS 22 RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS Open to any breeds native to countries outside the UK

CHAMPIONSHIP for classes 14- 22 1st & 2nd Prize winners to compete

CLASS 23 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEADING REIN / FIRST RIDDEN Ponies not exceeding 128cm riders 12years & under ponies will not canter together lead reins must be attached to the noseband.

CLASS 24 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN
Small breeds include Welsh A & B, Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor

CLASS 25 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN
Large Breeds include New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D
